INTRODUCTION

The Department of Comparative Jurisprudence & Policy of Sharia (College of Sharia and Islamic Studies) offers a Master of Sharia program in **Comparative Jurisprudence and Sources**. Both part-time and full time students are admitted to this program. Applicants are expected to memorize eight parts from the Holly Quran (1-6 & 29-30). Language of instruction is Arabic.

According to the University Council decision dated 4/2/2007, Thesis students admitted with effect from September 2007 are exempted from the comprehensive examination.
